

Griesbach OR The Clementine Gospel Tradition

TCGT was developed by researchers working on the Griesbach hypothesis. So some visitors may approach TCGT as if it is a variation on the Greisbach hypothesis.

Not so. TCGT is distinct from the Griesbach hypothesis. This is illustrated below.

bimah = a table from which the Torah is read and a desk.
